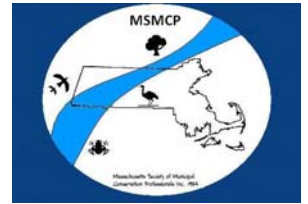

**Sediment and Erosion Control Workshop

140 Main St., Marlborough, MA

Paul McManus from EcoTec Inc. will cover best erosion control BMP's for construction sites including temporary basins, sediment treatment trains, use of flocculants, soil amendments, construction sequencing, when and where to use certain BMP's, how to measure turbidity and issues to be aware of when reviewing plans and conducting site inspections.



We'll start indoors for a short presentation then check out a large construction site being constructed by Avalon Bay -240 units of housing on a glacial till hill which has been a challenge.

Please come prepared for a field walk on a construction site with appropriate shoes and clothing— bring your hard hat if you have it. The workshop will be held rain or shine.
