# **Culvert Assessments (Field Trip)** **4417 Main Street, Palmer** **Police Station Conference Room** **Wednesday, September 28, 2016** **10:30am-1:30pm (note time changes)**

Conservation Agent Angela Panaccione will lead us in a brief training and overview of the North Atlantic Aquatic Connectivity Collaborative (NAACC) protocols for assessing road-stream crossings, in order to identify high priority bridge and culverts for upgrade and replacement. The Field Training will include a 30 Minute Indoor Training to briefly review survey, safety and protocols, answer questions, and distribute survey equipment. We will then spend about 2 Hours in the field surveying and reviewing protocols at 2-3 road-stream crossings.
