# **The Effects on Water Quality & Aquatic Plants by Deep Draw Downs**

In 1999 Bare Hill Pond in Harvard was listed on the Massachusetts 303(d) of the Federal Clean Water Act for Nuisance Aquatic Plants and lake quality being threatened by high phosphorus loadings. Since 2002 the pond has periodically been drawn down.

Wendy Gendron, an Aquatic Ecologist and owner of Aquatic Restoration Consulting, LLC, has been working with the Bare Hill Pond Watershed Management Committee for over ten years to monitor in-lake water quality and aquatic plants. Wendy will present results of this long term monitoring. She is a Certified Lake Manager and has been actively assessing, managing and protecting lakes and other aquatic environments for 23 years. She specializes in habitat assessments and water quality.
