Hone your tracking skills in the Montague sand plains. We will cover all the basics of animal track identification and interpretation with a special emphasis on animal gaits and reading the stories they tell. This session will be packed full of tracking tips as we search the sand for the signs of the wild animals that live there.



George Leoniak has a passion for sharing the art of animal tracking with people of all ages and experience levels. His school, The Mindful Tracker, combines both “outer” and “inner” tracking techniques that lead people to a deeper sense of connection to themselves and the natural world. He is recognized as a Senior Tracker by the international organization Cybertracker, and holds a M.S. in Conservation Biology and a B.A. in Biology and Educational Psychology.
