**Wildlife Habitat Restoration  
Pine Hill, Lancaster  
Thursday, August 21, 2014  
11:00am-1:00pm**

Chris Buelow of the MA Natural Heritage and Endangered Species Program will give a tour and talk about the Mass Wildlife's work to restore sandplain grassland, pitch pine and scrub-shrub habitat to benefit rare and endangered species in the Pine Hill area of the Bolton Flats.

**Directions** - from route 117 in Lancaster turn north on Harvard Road. Harvard Road turns sharply east at 0.4 miles and becomes Pine Hill Road. Cross the railroad tracks and there will be a gate on the north side of the road about 1/4 mile after the railroad crossing. We will meet at the gate.
